Independent Therapeutic Clown Artist, 2012 - present

Currently working in various health-care centres in Toronto in duo (i.e. with a therapeutic clown partner) on a regular basis alongside care staff to deliver patient-centred, individualized care to adults and elders coping with illness and/or disability with a focus on those with Dementia.

Elderclown Research Project - Therapeutic Clown Artist, 2013

➤One of four therapeutic clown artists selected to deliver frequent (3 days/week) therapeutic clown services to 24 participating elders with Dementia in a CIHR-funded study to measure the effects of therapeutic clown visits on Dementia patients. The 3-month study was conducted at Baycrest Hospital by Toronto Rehab Institute Research Scientist, Dr. Pia Kontos.

Primary therapeutic clown artist working in duo (i.e. with a therapeutic clown partner) delivering regular ongoing service to elders with Dementia in care settings in Toronto (Long-Term Care, day centres for seniors)

➤ Worked solo for five years on the neurology/trauma/orthopaedics units visiting patients and families regularly, twice a week.

Five years working solo on "occasional" basis, two days a month, filling in for absent therapeutic clowns as well as in the emergency and imaging departments.

Co-creator and co-facilitator of "Intro to Therapeutic Clowning" – a two-level introductory course designed for people interested in the profession of therapeutic clowning.

Child Life Volunteer/therapeutic clown - Hotel Dieu/Kingston General Hospital - 1997

➤ Worked as a volunteer in the Child-Life program at both hospitals. Circulated around the pediatrics ward as "Rosy the Story-maker-upper" engaging in imaginative play with children monthly over an eight month period.
